










THE MALPHURS GROUP

Beginning January 2016, Dr. Aubrey Malphurs of The Malphurs Group met one weekend a month for six months with 24 members of a Strategic Leadership Team. As they met each month Dr. Malphurs led them through an evaluation and strategic planning process which involved multiple key areas:

- Congregational Vision

This team evaluated the current course of the church using a ministry analysis, and initiated a strategic planning process for our future in light of our newly adopted mission ... "to know Christ intimately and share Him lovingly." The team agreed on five core values that will now be the focus of our ministry: Scripture, Fellowship, Worship, Evangelism and Service.

Implementation "Teams" were formed for several key areas of ministry:
